- Bat (Must meet USA Bat standard. Visit <https://www.littleleague.org/playing-rules/bat-information/> for more information). Coach pitch and up cannot use T-ball bat
- Baseball pants for practice (optional)

# BAT SIZING CHART

## BAT LENGTH



Extend one arm out to the side while holding the knob in the middle of your chest with the end cap pointing away from your body. If the end cap sits at your palm or wrist, the bat is probably too short; if the end cap sits past your index finger, the bat is likely too long. If the end cap is even with your knuckles, it is the correct length.

## BAT WEIGHT



Try to hold the bat in your extended hand for 45 seconds. If you can't comfortably hold the bat for this long, it is probably too heavy.
